- **Formal analysis:** application of statistical, mathematical, computational or other formal techniques to analyze or synthesize study data.
- **Acquisition of funds:** acquisition of financial support for the project leading to this publication.
- **Research:** conducting an investigation and research process, specifically performing experiments, or collecting data/evidence.
- **Methodology:** development or design of the methodology; creation of models.
- **Project administration:** management responsibility and coordination of the planning and execution of the research activity.
- **Resources:** supply of study materials, reagents, materials, patients, laboratory samples, animals, instrumentation, computer resources or other analytical tools.
- **Software:** programming, software development; software design; implementation of computer code and supporting algorithms; testing of existing code components.
- **Supervision:** supervisory and leadership responsibility in the planning and execution of research activities, including mentoring external to the core team.
- **Validation:** verification, either as part of the activity or separately, of the overall replicability/reproducibility of the results/experiments and other research outputs.
- **Visualization:** preparation, creation and/or presentation of published work, specifically the visualization/presentation of data.



- **Writing - original draft:** preparation, creation and/or presentation of the published work, specifically the writing of the initial draft (including substantive translation).
- **Writing - reviewing and editing:** preparation, creation and/or presentation of the published work by members of the original research group, specifically critical review, commentary or revision - including pre- or post-publication stages.
